Scott:

It was good to see you in Arlington this past week. I enjoyed our discussions regarding the City's satisfaction with your Weir-Wolf Automated Brush cleaning mechanism. As we discussed, the City of League City's Wastewater Department received a national award from Water Environment federation for safety. Part of our ability to receive that award is the fact that we no longer have personnel cleaning clarifiers, pulling hoses around, or standing awkwardly on the weirs or walls of clarifiers to hoses used to clean the clarifiers. Since the installation of the Weir-Wolf mechanisms on the six clarifiers at the Dallas Salmon Wastewater Treatment Plant we have had no such injuries. I attribute this in part to the brush cleaning mechanisms installed on the clarifiers. I think any city or municipality that is safety conscious should look into obtaining this equipment as it can reduce on-the-job injuries and lost time accidents. While your equipment is not the sole reason for the safety award, I credit in part the Weir-Wolf Automated Brush cleaning mechanism in allowing us to go three years without a lost time accident.

Again, I enjoyed seeing you at Arlington and look forward to meeting you again at Texas Water '98.
